How long does the assessment take to complete?

The assessment is highly prescriptive, and requires knowledge of your current SAP environment and configuration. Depending on the complexity of your landscape, it could take up to one hour to accurately document your current-state SAP environment. Once your current landscape is fully mapped, our team will begin analyzing S/4HANA deployment options, cost comparisons of each, and provide preliminary migration cost estimates along with other relevant information.

Once the data has been collected, the SAP® S/4HANA Technical TCO Assessment and report will be completed for your organization within 5-7 days.

Our SAP system touches many different departments within the organization. Will this assessment require me to involve them in the process?

The S/4HANA Technical TCO Assessment will require insights from your IT organization and SAP Operations team, and could require additional information from your accounting department.

Is there anything I can prepare in advance for the assessment?

While this assessment is highly collaborative between our teams, you can prepare for the meeting in advance by collecting the following information from the teams mentioned above:

- # of SAP users (*Professional & Limited*)
- SAP Licensing Model (*Current & Planned*)
- SAP Support Model & Requirement(s) (*Current & Planned*)
- SAP System Landscape(s) (*ECC, HANA, etc.*)
- SAP System Product Description(s) (*BW, BI, BOBJ, CRM, etc.*)
- # of SAP System Landscape & Product Location(s) (*Production, Quality, Development, Sandbox*)
- Disaster Recovery State & Requirement(s)
- Security & Compliance Requirement(s)
- Current-State Software & Support Costs
- Current-State Internal & External Infrastructure/Services Costs
